

FAQ

There follow our FAQs. We kindly ask you to read them to get a wider overview of Le Spighe and to judge them giving a feedback.

1 – What time are check in and check out?

Check in: from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m.

Check out: within 9.30 a.m.

2 – Which floor are the apartments?

All apartments are at the ground floor. 4 apartments have a mezzanine floor hosting a bedroom. One apartment is suitable to handicapped people.

3 – Are the prices per person or per apartment?

Prices are per apartment, but vary according to the number of persons.

4 – Is heating included?

Yes.

5 – Is air conditioning included?

Yes.

6 – Is final cleaning included?

No, it isn't: it is made at the end of the holiday and its price depends on the apartment. You can ask for a more frequent cleaning.

7 – Are there linen and towels?

Le Spighe gives its guests linen and towels, that will be changed once a week. Would you need a more frequent change, we will supply for it with a previous request. Beach towels are not available and guests are asked to provide on their own.

8 – Is there the safe?

Yes, there is a small safe in every room.

9 – Are rooms equipped with a TV?

Yes, every room has its own sat-TV.

10 – Are there telephone and Internet access?

Yes, they are both at your disposal. Furthermore, there's an internet corner with a computer and a printer in the reception.

11 – Where's the beach?

It is only 10 m away; you won't encounter any car or street while reaching it through the small path.

12 – Will the guests be provided with umbrellas and deckchairs?

Not really on the beach, but you have sunbeds and big sunombrellas outside your apartment.
